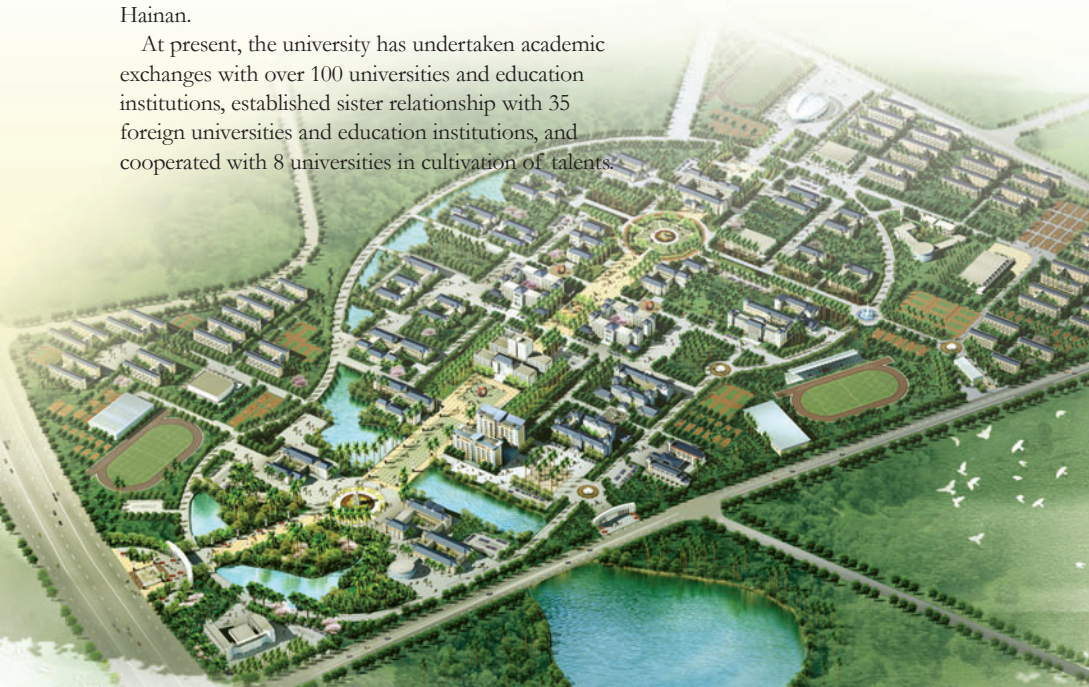


# Introduction

Hainan Normal University is located in Haikou, the capital of Hainan Province. Established in 1949, it is one of the key universities in Hainan in terms of overall strength. The school comprises 18 faculties and 30 research institutions. There are 53 undergraduate majors, 9 provincial key disciplines, 4 provincial research bases of humanities and social sciences, 11 first-level master disciplines and 4 first-level doctoral disciplines. In the school, 869 faculty members, including 462 with senior professional skill qualification, instruct over 20,000 students.

The university started to enroll international students in 1988. Now it is one of the first schools approved to admit international students by State Education Commission, one of the first Chinese education bases established by Overseas Chinese Affairs Office of the State Council, the school with Chinese Government Scholarship and Hainan Government Scholarship available for international students, is the Southeast Asian Teachers' Training Base for Promotion of Chinese, under the approval of Confucius Institute Headquarters / Hanban, and the site for HSK in Hainan.

At present, the university has undertaken academic exchanges with over 100 universities and education institutions, established sister relationship with 35 foreign universities and education institutions, and cooperated with 8 universities in cultivation of talents.





# Strengths of the University

## 1. Complete Facilities

With three campuses at Longkunnan, Guilinyang, and Lingshan, Hainan Normal University covers an area of 1,500,000 square meters. We also have 2 key laboratories co-founded by Hainan Province and the Ministry of Education, 3 provincial key laboratories, 1 national model center of experimental teaching and 5 provincial model centers of experimental teaching. We offer 205 internship bases for students and 157,500,000 volumes of books in the library for students and teachers.

With multi-media classrooms, students' reading rooms and multi-media terrace report halls, the buildings for Chinese language teaching occupy 3,500 square meters. The Chinese culture experience museum boasts an area of 4,489 square meters, including a Chinese traditional

handicraft classroom, costume and textile exhibition hall, calligraphy and painting exhibition hall, tea art demonstration hall and Chinese martial art hall.

## 2. All-round Services

We are active, enthusiastic, considerate and effective in delivering services to students, such as airport pickup and orientation. Hainan has 2 airports, Meilan International Airport in Haikou and Phoenix International Airport in Sanya with over 30 international flights and 100 domestic flights. It boasts a Cross-Sea Railway, Western Railway and Eastern Railway.

## 3. Beautiful Environment

The school is located in Haikou, a coastal tourist city and designated national historic and cultural city. Hainan is the southernmost province and the only tropical island in China.



## 4.About Hainan and Haikou

- Hainan Island lies on the same latitude as Hawaii, and is therefore often referred to as China's Hawaii. With an average temperature of 23.8 C, it has a long summer and no winter. The province has an area of 34,000 sq km. With its enormous maritime area, Hainan Province borders the neighboring countries of Vietnam and the Philippines.
- Hainan's main rivers originate from the mountainous centre and flow in different directions towards the coastal plains. The island's highest peak is Wuzhishan, standing 1867 m.
- The island has a volcanic origin, with a rugged mountainous centre surrounded by coastal plains on all sides. Hainan has 1528 km of coastline with numerous superb sandy beaches.
- Hainan has more than 4,000 species of plants, 344 species of birds and 77 kinds of animals, of which gibbons, rhesus monkeys and civet cats have been put under state protection.
- Haikou is Hainan's capital and with a population of about 2 million, it is also its largest city. Often referred to as the city of coconut palms, Haikou is the political, economical and cultural center of the island. It also features great shopping, dining, golf and entertainment options.

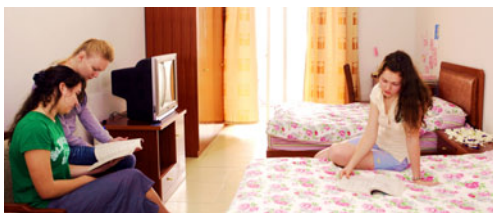
## 3. Accommodation Charge

## 4. Other Costs

- (1) Residence permit application: about RMB 800 Person/year, subject to the actual cost at time of enrollment.
- (2) Physical examination: about RMB 400/Person/year, subject to the actual cost at time of enrollment.
- (3) Textbook: RMB 400/person/ year, subject to the actual cost at time of enrollment.
- (4) Accommodation deposit: RMB 500/person, refundable when articles in the premise are intact.
- (5) Insurance: about RMB 500 yuan, subject to the actual cost at time of enrollment.





## Session Period

Hainan Normal University offers spring and autumn sessions. Typically, the former lasts from March to July, and the latter from September to January of next year.

### 1. Students of non-diploma education:

Those with basic Chinese can apply for admission anytime and will be arranged into a class according to his/her performance in a test and an interview. Beginners of Chinese cannot be admitted anytime.

Application deadline for the spring session: January 20th

Registration time for the spring session: February 26th to 28th

Starting date of the spring session: March 1st

Application deadline for the autumn session: July 31st

Check-in time for the autumn session: August 29th to 31st

Starting date of the autumn session: September 1st

### 2. Students of diploma education:

Registration in Autumn

Application deadline: July 31st

Registration time: August 29th to 31st

Starting date of the session: September 1st

## Enrollment Procedure

**1. Application.** The applicant can submit the application by email or fax. The application form can be requested from the school or can be downloaded from the school website.

**2. Submission of Material.** The applicant shall send the application form, a scanned copy of their physical examination certificate and a colored scanned copy of their passport to the email of the International Students Enrollment Office of the School of International Cultural Exchange, Hainan Normal University. In addition, the applicant for diploma education shall also submit a diploma copy, school report, HSK certificate and other materials.

**3. Examination of qualification.** Your qualification for any program will be examined. Once approved, you will receive a letter of admission.

**4. Payment of tuition.** After receiving the letter, you shall remit the tuition to the account of the University as stated below :

5. **Visa application.** The University will help you to apply for your visa to China (Form JW202). Once approved, we will send you the original copy.

6. **Visa formalities.** You shall finish the visa formalities with the letter of admission, Form JW202, physical examination certificate and passport in the Chinese embassy or Chinese general consulate in your country.

7. **Registration.** Please arrive to the University for registration with the letter of admission, passport and eight passport photos, and pay the accommodation fee and other applicable charges.

## Scholarships

### 1. Chinese Government Scholarship

Chinese Government Scholarship is classified into Bachelor scholarship, Master scholarship, Doctor scholarship, Chinese language student scholarship, General student scholarship and advanced student scholarship. The applicant can apply for this scholarship to the international student organization agency, Chinese embassy or consulate in your country, or other valid organizations. The period for application usually begins at the beginning of January and ends at the beginning of April, subject to the time specified by the international student organization agency in your country.

## 2. Confucius Institute Scholarship

The category of scholarship includes Scholarship for Students of Master's Degree in Teaching Chinese to Speakers of Other Languages (MTC SOL) , Scholarship for Students of One-Academic-Year + MTC SOL, Scholarship for One-Academic-Year Students, and Scholarship for One-Semester Students. You can apply for this scholarship to the Enrollment Office of School of International Cultural Exchange, Hainan Normal University .The specified period which is usually from the beginning of January to the beginning of April.
